Qualified Imperacer® Assay for the Quantification of Interleukin 1 beta (IL-1β) in Human Synovial Fluid

Interleukin 1 beta (IL-1β):

Interleukin 1 beta (IL-1 β) is a pro-inflammatory cytokine. Released by activated macrophages, the proprotein is proteolytically processed to its active form, which plays a role in inflammatory response, apoptosis and cell proliferation. Elevated levels of IL-1 β have been observed in patients with diabetic retinopathy.

IL-1α is also known as leukocytic pyrogen, leukocytic endogenous mediator, mononuclear cell factor and lymphocyte activating factor. Because " β " is sometimes mistaken as " β ", which translates to "ss", several variations in writings occur.
